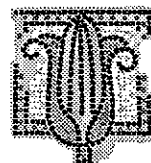

## POWERPOINT PRESENTATION CREATION & DESIGN<sup>A</sup>

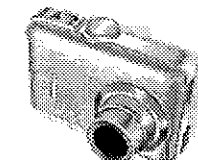
