

CHILD CARE SUBSIDY

CEACA can help pay childcare costs for students in our **funded courses, marked with ^**. The subsidy applies to short courses and full year certificates. Our classes are small, supportive and many are nationally accredited, so why not call for the list of eligible child care providers and book a class?

CEACA is registered with Centrelink, those receiving some benefits may be eligible for financial assistance to complete an accredited course. Eligible courses are marked with an asterisk *

Many of the programs in this brochure are subsidised by funding from Adult Community and Further Education (ACFE) to improve access for all members of the community. CEACA charges the required fees for these courses, including the set minimum tuition fee of \$50 plus a materials and amenities fee.

TAGINES

NEW

Tagines are earthenware cooking pots found in North Africa (Morocco, Algeria, Tunisia and Libya).

A traditional tagine is not indispensable as very good results are obtained in a cooking dish with a tight fitting lid. Tagines involve slow simmering of less expensive cuts of meat with a medley of ingredients and seasonings. Lamb or chicken with dried or fresh fruit and a dash of "Ras el hanout" (Moroccan spice mix) is inexpensive and melts in the mouth. Tagines can also be vegetarian and still delicious. Taste the results on the day or bring a container. Take home a spice mix to practice.

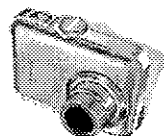
DIGITAL CAMERAS & PICASA (PHOTO EDITOR)^

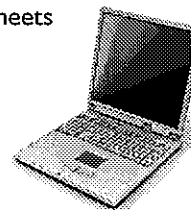

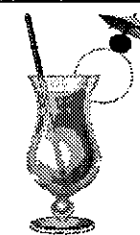

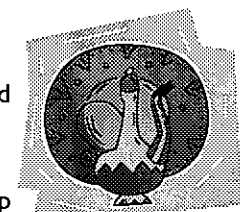
